

REACH and RoHS Policy

REACH – Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals

RoHS – Restriction of the use of certain Harmful Substances

- Under REACH, masterbatches are considered as preparations – a mixture of unreacted substances with different chemical identity.
- Nexam Chemical Group works with all its raw material suppliers and takes all necessary measures to ensure continued availability and supply of all substances used in their products.
- We can confirm that, to the best of our knowledge, our raw material suppliers (manufacturers and importers) have met REACH registration requirements.
- Nexam Chemical Group is compliant with REACH Regulation (EU) No 1907/2006.
